Dear Parents/Guardians,

As informed in the February Letter and during our last Parent-Teacher Conference 1, the school will cease the issuance of our monthly letter to parents/guardians with the implementation of Class Dojo. Instead, we will disseminate school information that parents/guardians need to know via “School Story” on Class Dojo.

Currently, we have about 93% of the parents/guardians who have completed the Class Dojo onboarding. For those who are yet to be on board, the school will continue to reach out to you during the upcoming home visits to support you in completing your onboarding.

### **FOR YOUR ACTION**

#### 1) **Class Dojo Onboarding – Enabling Notifications**

Parents/Guardians are encouraged to **enable notifications for Class Dojo** on your mobile device to receive and respond timely to any school information disseminated. We have created a simple instructional video to guide you to do so. Please scan the QR code to access the videos:

From Term 2 onwards, parents/guardians will also be able to provide consent for CCA/Level/Vocational Education activities via an **online consent form**. Such information will be disseminated to you by your child’s/ward’s CCA/Class/Vocational Education teachers via **class announcements or messages on Class Dojo**.

#### 2) **Travel Declaration for March Holidays**
